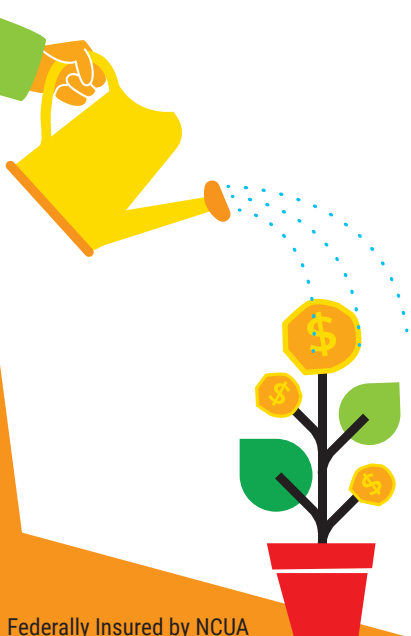

Color the word **SMART** and learn what it stands for along the way:




### Specific

Know how much you need




### Achievable
